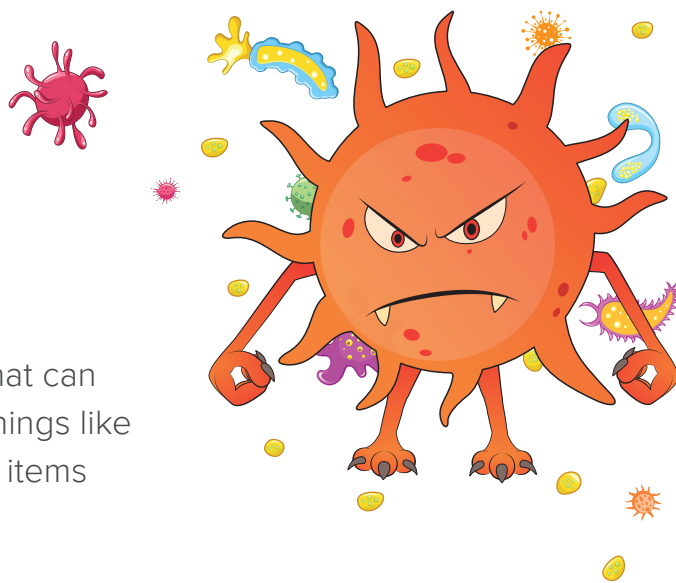


Interactive Experiment: Understanding Germs
